Instructions for School Districts

General Information

Additional explanatory notes and definitions are included with the usage reports or appear on the Web sites noted for each database vendor below.

Account numbers and username/password information needed for accessing usage reports appear in the "NOTES" area of your library's "**Discus Institutional Summary.**" Those who serve as Primary Contacts for their districts may request a copy of the summary. If the login information recorded on the summary is no longer valid, please contact the appropriate vendor for new login credentials.

Several products are set up under a single Discus master account. Therefore, usage reports specific to individual school districts are not available.

Home usage: It is **not** possible to obtain reports showing your district's home use of any of the databases provided by Discus. This is because all schools share the same off-site usage "accounts" for this access.

Click on the "Reports & Statistics" tab located at the top of the screen. 4. From there you can run and schedule reports. 5. Standard reports are the most popular to run and capture the most information. Once you are logged in, you have the option of changing the administrator information. To do this, click on [Edit Options] under the ADMINISTRATOR LOGINS header. Fill in all the required information and click submit. 4. To view usage, click on the [View/Schedule Usage Statistics Report] link near the upper left of the page. 5. This will bring you to the Usage Statistics page. Select the Report Type, Delivery Method, time frame, and click the CREATE button. 6. The report is displayed in the browser window and you can print it using the print functionality of the browser.
